

2018-2019 Types of Scholarships

- 1) **Academic Scholarships**: Eligible students are First-Time, Full-Time, Regularly Admitted, Degree Seeking College Students that have never attended another college since graduating from High School. College classes taken prior to your first regularly admitted semester do not affect awarding Deans or Presidential Scholarships but can affect future eligibility. A scholarship application is **required** and available through Pipeline by clicking on the "Apply for Scholarships" quick click. The scholarship application deadline for the fall semester is August 1st, the scholarship deadline for the spring semester is January 1st and the scholarship deadline for the summer semester is May 1st. This policy affects students that are applying for the first time for an academic scholarship during the 2018-2019 academic year. Students that have earned their associate degree are no longer eligible for academic scholarships.

- 2) **Foundation Scholarships**: Scholarships provided to the college by private, corporate, and organizational funds administered by the Butler Community College Foundation. A Scholarship Application is required and available in Pipeline by clicking on the "Apply for Scholarships" quick click. A list of Foundation Scholarships and their criteria is available on the application website.
- 3) **Technical Scholarships**: Scholarships provided as an incentive for people who could not or would not otherwise enroll in technical programs at Butler. Awards are available for \$265 for 12 or more hours and \$132.50 is available for 6-11 credit hours. A scholarship application is required and is available upon request.
- 4) **Activity/Athletic Scholarships**: Provided by various departments to students who wish to participate in activities such as sports, livestock judging, journalism, theater, music, spirit squad, etc. These scholarships cover the cost of books and tuition. Individual departments make the selection and students should contact the division dean, instructor, or coach for information.
- 5) **Butler Access Scholarships**: Scholarships provided to students on a first-come first-serve basis who have not attended high school or college in the past 12 months and are not grant eligible. The entire list of criteria for this scholarship is on the application. A scholarship application is required and is available on Pipeline, Butler's webpage, and upon request. The scholarship covers tuition only for a maximum of six credit hours in one semester.
- 6) **Kansas Board of Regents Scholarships**: The State of Kansas provides various scholarships for Kansas residents. Examples: Ethnic Minority, Nursing, State, Teacher, Military, and Technical. Applications and a complete list of scholarships are available through their website at www.kansasregents.org.
